- Payment must be made by STANDING ORDER each quarter (i.e. no cash or cheques) on the required date. You will be provided with the account details and your personal reference once your application form is received so you can set this up.

PLEASE DO NOT SET UP YOUR STANDING ORDER UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED YOUR PERSONAL REFERENCE.

50% of all money raised from the Itton & Howick Village Hall 100 Club will go towards the hall's funds and the remaining 50% will be used for the 100 Club prize fund. The prize fund is capped at £300 if there are more than 100 tickets sold.

The Itton & Howick 100 Club Rules

1. The 100 Club will be operated and supervised by the Itton & Howick Village Hall Committee.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter the Rules of the 100 Club as may be necessary. A copy of the rules will be available on the website ittonhowickvillagehall.org.uk.
3. The aim of the Club is to raise funds for the Itton & Howick Village Hall.
4. The draw will normally take place at a suitable hall event (e.g. social event or village bar night) and in the presence of at least three committee members, at least one of whom will be the Chair or the Treasurer.
5. The 100 Club is open to all residents of Itton and Howick. If members move away from the area, they must cancel their membership by contacting ittonvillagehall@gmail.com and cancelling the standing order.
6. Members must be aged 16 years or over.
7. Membership will be by subscription of £6 per quarter per number and paid quarterly on the following dates: 25 February; 25 May; 25 August; 25 November.
8. Members may have more than one number, on payment of additional subscriptions.
9. All payments must be made in full by STANDING ORDER on the required dates. Cash or cheques are not acceptable.
10. Members will be provided with the necessary bank information and their own reference once their signed and completed application form is received.
11. The regular quarterly prize fund will be 50% of the relevant quarter's income (capped at £300) and there will be three prizes as follows:
 - 1st prize = 1/2 of the quarterly prize fund.
 - 2nd prize = 1/3 of the quarterly prize fund.
 - 3rd prize = 1/6 of the quarterly prize fund.
12. A register will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them. Members should advise the Treasurer if their contact details change.
13. Winners will be contacted personally by email and their names will be posted on the Itton & Howick Notice Board and the Hall's Face Book page after each draw. If a winner cannot be contacted for any reason, the winnings will be placed into the hall funds after 6 months.
14. Participants can cancel their membership at any time by giving written notice by email to treasurer@ittonhowickvillagehall.co.uk. Any decision by the Hall Committee to wind up the 100 Club will also be by written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.

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
